

**POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT  
FOR THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT  
FOR THE MIDDLE DISTRICT OF FLORIDA, ORLANDO DIVISION**

The Honorable Arthur B. Briskman is seeking a law clerk for a temporary position during a maternity leave absence from approximately late October 2008 through early January 2009. Salary is based on the Federal Government General Schedule and the applicant's qualifications.

Any applicant must be a member in good standing of the bar of a state, territorial, or federal court of general jurisdiction or a recent law school graduate, but such graduate must have:

- a) Graduated within the upper third of his/her class from a law school accredited by the American Bar Association; or
- b) Served on the editorial board of the law review of such a school or other comparable academic achievement.

Superior writing, research, and analytical abilities and strong organizational skills are essential. Experience in bankruptcy law is preferred.

Primary duties include: assisting in the preparation for hearings and trials; performing legal research; drafting orders and opinions; tracking under advisement matters.
